

COVID-19 Statement

Kawartha Football will be safely monitoring participants, members, coaches, and volunteers at all Kawartha Football events (Touch Football League, 705 Training, CFL Futures) in the search and prevention of the presence of COVID-19

Any participant, member, coach, or volunteer experiencing symptoms are recommended to stay home. Any of the above individuals showing signs of illness will not be permitted within the Kawartha Football held event (Touch Football League, 705 Training, CFL Futures) – these include, but are not limited to:

- Fever (temperature of 38 degrees Celsius or higher)
- Rough cough
- Struggle breathing
- Congested Nose

All individuals may be required to wear masks while entering/exiting any Kawartha Football event. Participants will not be required to wear masks while performing physical activity outside. Coaches, members, and volunteers will have the option to wear a mask or not while outdoors.

All individuals will be required to wear masks while in any indoor run Kawartha Football event.

To maintain social distancing and to comply with the Province of Ontario's guidelines for maximum gathering sizes, spectators will not be permitted in any Kawartha Football event. There will be Kawartha Football members and Kawartha Football volunteers at entrances/exits mandating this policy. Spectators are welcome to watch while outside of the Kawartha Football event (outside a fencing area, glass windows, etc.)
